Recommendation #3:Asarin in Nakaniida Karaku Koji(street)

Asarin is a popular store that everyone in Kami Town has been to at least once. This is a Japanese sweets store that sells handmade Japanese sweets that can only be found here.

Here are some particularly popular sweets.

Shiratama (dumpling) is made of white balls with sweet bean paste or zunda on top. Zunda is a very
